

CVG Virtual Visits 2020: Visit 2, Gainsborough and Corringham.

The second part of our first trip was to be to Gainsborough and Corringham, two contrasting churches neither of which I've visited before. Corringham St Laurence is the older church with origins in the Saxo-Norman period. Gainsborough All Saints is mostly Georgian, a big town church that wouldn't be out of place in London. Also very similar to Derby Cathedral with the main body of the church replaced in the 18th century but retaining its fine Gothic tower. Both churches are graded in the Jenkins 1000 Best Churches.
